The Carle Cancer Institute Normal recognizes that the global Coronavirus (COVID-19) is a serious public health concern.

Because we are a facility that cares for patients at higher risk for complications from viruses like COVID-19, we are implementing the following **precautionary measures until further notice**:

VISITORS: Please no visitors at this time unless the patient you are accompanying requires a guardian present. We ask that any visitor who has:

- A cough, fever or trouble breathing or
- Recently traveled outside of the county or
- Have been in close contact with persons who have traveled to a location where Coronavirus has been diagnosed
- **To please stay home and do not come into the building.**

PATIENTS: Those scheduled for treatments/appointments:

- Who have developed a cough, fever or trouble breathing or have been in close contact with persons with these symptoms should call their doctor **BEFORE** coming to the Carle Cancer Institute Normal.
- Further instructions will be given to you at that time.
